Te Tokorima-a-Mahuika | Self Review Tool

The first thing to do is to complete the Self Review Tool. There's 15 questions to help you work out how 'ready' you are for Hangarau Matihiko and Digital Technologies curricula content. The results are confidential to you but you are free to share them with your school or kura. You can come back to the Self Review Tool to measure your progress at any time.
